Becoming a Provider

The Familyhome Program is designed for you to share your home and family life with an adult or child with an intellectual disability.

You and the individual will be introduced through gradual visits and will move in as soon as everyone is comfortable.

We hope that for many, this will be a long-term relationship. For others, this may be a stepping-stone for independent living in the community.



The benefits...

- ◆ You will instantly see the difference you are making in a person's life.
- ◆ Familyhome Support Workers provide ongoing support and training through regular contact and home visits.
- ◆ Full-time & Relief Providers receive a non-taxable, daily payment for the care and support of each individual.



Screening

A homestudy / interview will be completed to help the Familyhome Support Worker find an appropriate match for you. All information gathered will be kept confidential.

Respite

The Familyhome Program also offers short-term relief to natural families supporting a loved one at home with one of our approved Familyhome Providers.



We believe...

People with intellectual disabilities have the same rights, choice and access to services and supports as everyone else. We are dedicated to helping people obtain what is important to them by providing opportunities and the supports needed to become full participating members of their community.

Am I qualified?

The real qualifications needed to become a Familyhome Provider are a genuine interest in providing a caring home environment.

Providers can be single, a couple or a family whose lifestyles complement those of the individuals and who are willing to provide a long-term commitment.
