


WHAT IS THE INFANT DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM?

It is a program that:

 Services families of infants and children from birth to five years of age who may have delays or are at risk for delays in development.

 Specializes in early intervention and assessment


 Is free of cost to families



WHAT SERVICES ARE PROVIDED?

 Service coordination

 Developmental assessments

 Family service plans and individual program plans designed to assist the parents in providing appropriate activities and experiences based specifically on their infant's or child's needs

 Information regarding other community services and referrals are made as required

 Individual/group support and education

REFERRALS:

Referrals may be made by parents, physicians, hospitals, community agencies



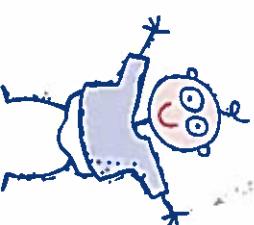
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COCHRANE TEMISKAMING Infant Development Program
