We are looking for someone with lived experience (having developmental disability) to join the Ethics Committee and participate as a full member in important discussions about how people with developmental disability are supported.

Sitting on the Ethics Committee will give you a chance to help develop good supportive Person Centred Plans for people with developmental disability.

You will also have a chance to talk about issues in supporting people with disability when trying to make sure their rights are respected.

You will have the assistance and guidance of other members of the committee who, together, review Person Centred Plans in a friendly and helpful manner.

Some reading is required in order to review the written plan. Support can be arranged to assist with understanding the material.

The committee meets about 4 times a year and each meeting lasts about 2 to 3 hours.

The successful member will be provided \$50.00 or a gift card of that amount for each meeting attended.
