The CTRC Management Team continues to meet to discuss any care and support issues in this Covid-19 Period.

We would like to talk vacation and travel.

- ✓ **Currently the Canadian Government is advising against all non-essential travel to other countries.**
- ✓ **Any returning Canadians are still required to quarantine for 14 days.**
- ✓ **Newfoundland & Labrador, Prince Edward Island, New Brunswick and all the Territories are closed to all out of province visitors.**
- ✓ **Manitoba and Nova Scotia will allow you to visit but ask that you isolate 14 days once you enter the province.**
- ✓ **Ontario, Quebec, B.C. are advising against all non-essential travel within and outside of the province.**
- ✓ **Given that some areas of the province are still in Stage One of re-opening (often referred to as a “Hot Spot”), please exercise greater caution if you must travel to these areas to help keep the individuals we support, you and your colleagues and our families safe. CTRC encourages all staff to avoid travel to these areas if possible.**
- ✓ **Several travel and private insurance plans are not covering individuals that contract Covid-19 during travel.**

- ✓ **Our Desjardins travel insurance continues to cover out of province and country travel. HOWEVER they point out the Canadian Government is advising against all non-essential travel at this time. Please call Desjardins at 1-800-263-1810 before any travel for updated information on your coverage within and outside of Canada. Coverage may change as Covid-19 evolves.**
- ✓ **Covid-19 may limit travel and vacation plans for some time to come. We encourage you to consider all travel advisories, restrictions and requirements ahead of any travel within or outside of Canada.**
- ✓ **Keep informed, keep safe and keep in-touch if traveling and returning to work.**
- ✓ **Your wellness is key to us and the individuals we all support.**
