The CTRC Management Team met today to discuss any care and support issues in this Covid-19 Period.

- ✓ We would please remind all staff that if tested for Covid-19 and no matter the results, please inform your Supervisor or Human Resources. It is a matter of Public Health, Workplace Health and Safety and directed by Order in Counsel under the Ontario Emergency Orders.
- ✓ Paramedical services (PT/OT and Behaviour Services Ontario) will be cleared to enter CTRC Homes for any needed essential services/assessments.
- ✓ Virtual assessments will be used and exhausted ahead of an in person visit to the home.
- ✓ Screening and use of PPE will be required for any visit into a home by paramedical services.
- ✓ Hospital visits for urgent care continue.
- ✓ Non-urgent assessments (x-ray, swallowing assessment, etc.) may resume but will be directed and planned by CTRC Health Services.
- ✓ Planning for the Professional Resource Team to extend some first face-to-face assessments is moving along (still a ways off).

- ✓ **Social distancing and new office practices to be in place ahead of re-opening office space are being reviewed. These will include sanitization points, restricted areas, wait and yield area for staff to circulate, food storage and preparation considerations, visitor considerations, etc.**
