The CTRC Management Team has met today in its continued Covid-19 response:

- ✓ The easing of Covid-19 restrictions in Ontario has provided for several anecdotal reports of groups gathering, more people out and about and poor practice of social distancing.
- ✓ Residents and workers in Long Term Care/Congregated Care in Ontario remain at risk and we are directing you to continue wearing your mask at work.
- ✓ Outside of work, in any setting where social distancing is difficult, we ask that you consider wearing your cloth mask for your protection and that of our residences.
- ✓ The CTRC management team is also discussing and planning our next steps around easing some restrictions in line with Government guidelines and pandemic response best practice.
- ✓ We are seeking, in Residential Services, your input around safe activities outside the homes we could do with our individuals. These would need to respect social distancing from the general public but allow the home to be out as a group. Bring suggestions to your Supervisors for discussion with the larger management group.
