“WASH YOUR HANDS, PHYSICALLY DISTANCE, STAY SAFE”

The CTRC Management Team continues to meet to discuss any care and support issues in this Covid-19 period.

- ✓ The Ontario Government has extended the “Reopening Ontario Act 2020” until September 22nd and all regulations formally part of the original Emergency Orders.
- ✓ They have also extended the requirement to work only for one employer and continue to allow for staff redeployment, staffing changes and streamlining of requirements as required to respond to Covid-19.
- ✓ The Government will review, ahead of the September 22nd date, the need to further extend the Reopening Ontario Act 2020 and the regulations applicable to our sector.
- ✓ The new Federal Government plan to pay 10 sick days to employees without paid sick benefits, was announced yesterday. However, this first needs to be voted in parliament (September 23rd) and details remain to be received by employers. We will communicate information as we receive it.
