The Cochrane Temiskaming Resource Centre (CTRC) is seeking a Community Support Worker to join its team at our Timmins and James Bay locations. CTCRC is a regional Developmental Services provider offering programs across the Districts of Temiskaming and Cochrane including coastal communities along James and Hudson Bay. The successful candidate will work collaboratively within a multi-disciplinary team offering supports to individuals with Developmental Disabilities, their families and service providers.

Community Support Workers act as the initial link to CTCRC in the intake and case management capacity, by representing the needs of individual(s) requesting particular services and by completing intake and acting upon the decisions of the Professional Resource Team regarding service delivery and assisting individuals and families to access other community supports and government services.

The successful candidate will be required to work in the coastal communities for ten (10) weeks throughout the year. While working up the coast the successful candidate will receive twenty eight (28) dollars per day supplement and the reimbursement of their cost for water.

Wages: \$27.41 to 29.73 per hour

Hours of Work: 75 hours / 2 weeks

QUALIFICATIONS: A Social Service Worker Diploma or Social Worker Degree or proof of registration with Ontario College of Social Workers and Social Service Workers, will be considered as meeting the education requirement.
