The CTCRC Management Team continues to meet to discuss any care and support issues in this Covid-19 period.

- ✓ Please note Covid-19 active cases are rising in our service areas with 17 active cases in Temiskaming and 8 in the Cochrane District. (1 in Timmins)
- ✓ The Province has announced a Lockdown in our region starting December 26<sup>th</sup> at 12:01 a.m. and ending January 9<sup>th</sup> at 12 midnight. (May be extended if needed)
- ✓ No visits in or outside the homes from December 26<sup>th</sup>, 2020 to January 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
- ✓ Any essential visitor requests will need to be directed to our CTCRC Supervisors.
- ✓ Any service staff entering the home will be required to wear PPE's as directed by our Health Services (HS) Nurse. (see HS memo)
- ✓ All Passport visits are to be suspended December 26<sup>th</sup>, 2020 to January 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
- ✓ The Porcupine and Temiskaming Health Units are asking us to rethink any out of district travel and if you must travel to self-isolate 10 to 14 days ahead of travel and upon returning.
- ✓ If you must self-isolate around travel plans please note LOA and vacation request should be made ASAP.
