"WASH YOUR HANDS, PHYSICALLY DISTANCE, STAY SAFE"

- ✓ The Porcupine Health Unit has issued directives around families of school age children suspected of having Covid-19 (presenting symptoms).
- ✓ Employees with school age children will be required to self-isolate if their child has Covid-19 symptoms.
- ✓ They are required to stay home and self-isolate UNTIL:

a) The symptomatic individual receives a negative Covid-19 test result.
OR
b) they receive an alternative diagnosis by a health care professional.

- ✓ If the symptomatic individual does not seek COVID-19 testing, <u>all</u> <u>household contacts must self-isolate for 14 days from their last contact</u> <u>with that symptomatic individual</u>.
- ✓ If you are required to self-isolate and stay home because your school age child is suspected of having Covid-19 we will work with you.
- ✓ Please inform your Supervisor.
- ✓ If calling into the Group Home ahead of a shift call-in an "Emergency LOA" so the home staff may start the coverage process.
- ✓ You are not required to disclose to co-workers that you are needing to selfisolate.

- ✓ A CTRC Supervisor will call you. We will gather details, including if you are presenting with symptoms.
- ✓ We will explore what time banks to use to cover the time off (Lieu time, Stat Time, Vacation or Sick-time if applicable).
- ✓ The practice of requiring 2 weeks of notice to use vacation time will not apply in a case where you are ordered by the Public Health Unit to self-isolate.
- ✓ You may also remain on LOA and access Government of Canada funds intended to cover a required self-isolation period ordered by a Public Health Office.
- Please note the most important part is to follow the Public Health Guidelines and ensure safety for all.
- ✓ You may call me with any questions.

Keep up the Infections Control Practices. They have been effective to date!
