- ✓ Timmins and area is heading into the Victoria Day Long Weekend under a state of Emergency, facing multiple outbreak locations across the city and we have the 2nd highest infection rate in Ontario.
- ✓ Covid-19 cases in Timmins are serious and several patients have been transferred from TDH to other hospitals outside of region for more intensive supports. All available resources are stretched to the limit.
- ✓ The past long weekends in Ontario have resulted in infection rate spikes. We have over 2,500 provincial Covid-19 cases reported today! Any increase from that point is alarming.
