GET A VACCINE

- ✓ Timmins is set to move into Phase 1 of the Ontario Reopening Plan Friday June 25<sup>th</sup>.
- ✓ Dr. Catton, Chief Medical Officer with the Porcupine Health Unit, is still urging us to be cautious.
- ✓ Ministry regulations still require the maintenance of all infection prevention and control measures currently in place (e.g., mask, face shield, wellness check, extra cleaning, etc.).
- ✓ Visits for residents will resume on June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2021. That is 2 weeks after a second dose of vaccine for individuals in care. Clarification memo to residential homes to follow.
- ✓ MCCSS Enhanced Precaution guidelines remain in effect for visits. Parents and guardian may visit with proper PPE. Overnight visits to the parent or guardian's home are permitted. Brief hugs are allowed.
- ✓ Passport services and client outings will also resume with further clarification to follow.
- ✓ The Ministry of Labour order to up-date our wellness screening is further being clarified:
  - Review the long standing laminated Staff Wellness check form. (Not the other paper form)
  - Sign the “New” updated signature form.
  - If well, enter the workplace.
  - Inform and request a second staff to sign that you have completed the wellness check.
  - PRT and Satellite location staff may use the on-line tools.

**NOTE: A temperature verification with the thermometer is not required.**

**NOTE: The second staff signature is only an acknowledgement that a co-worker coming into work has in fact completed the wellness check.**

**NOTE: The second staff is not completing the screen or verifying or confirming the wellness of a co-worker.**

**Keep up the Infection Control Practices.
